The Assault occurred on 8-16-11 at aprox 2215 hrs. Due to the nature of the head injury [REDACTED] did not check into [REDACTED] until 8-20-11.

I interviewed Victim [REDACTED] post surgery at [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] was drifting in and out of sleep during the interview. [REDACTED] stated that she was walking home from the area of the [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] was dressed in female clothing at the time of the attack. A white female accompanied by a male began following [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated that the female was carrying a baseball bat. [REDACTED] stated that she crossed the street at 28th and NW 67th Street. The female came up along side [REDACTED] and told her "I don't want to see you around the skate bowl anymore". The female then struck [REDACTED] on the right side of the head with the baseball bat. [REDACTED] continued to her residence. The severity of the injury became apparent after several days. The on duty nurse at [REDACTED] stated to me that [REDACTED] sustained a subdural hematoma. The symptoms appear slowly and is fatal if not attended to. A portion of [REDACTED] skull was removed for treatment of the injury. [REDACTED] stated that she has seen the suspect before in the area of the skate park.
